ASSC ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

Form D

Participation with Alyeska Ski Club, (ASC) and the Glacier Valley Ski Education Foundation (GVSEF) (hereafter the ASSC and the GVSEF will be collectively referred to as The Club) is a privilege that can be revoked. Each member is an ambassador of The Club, the Alyeska Resort, and the Alaska Division at all times, both on and off grounds of The Club. Therefore each member will know and comply with all rules, and understand that violations of rules and policies may result in disciplinary action imposed by Club officials.

I acknowledge, understand, and agree to abide by the Junior Program Athlete Code of Conduct and pledge to uphold the spirit of this Code of Conduct, which offers a general guide to my conduct. Therefore, I pledge and agree to the following:

1. I will at all times display the conduct and integrity expected of me as an athlete and a representative of The Club and conduct myself in a manner that will not bring disrespect, discredit, or dishonor to myself, my teammates, The Club, Alaska Division, USSA, my country or organizer of an event in which I participate.
2. I will Respect and abide by all Alyeska Resort Rules and Directives from Alyeska Resort employee's while on Alyeska Resort property and at the Alyeska Resort Ski Area. As well as all Rules and Directives from all other ski area's management and employee's while at that ski area's property.
3. I will conform to all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations I will also comply with any rules, regulations, and codes that may be established for events, programs, and activities in which I participate, including but not limited to the USSA Code of Conduct (found in the USSA Alpine Competition Guide).
4. I will act in a sportsmanlike manner consistent with the spirit of fair play and responsible conduct.
5. I will refrain from conduct detracting from my ability or that of my teammates to attain peak performance.
6. I will respect the property of others whether personal or public.
7. I will respect members of my team, other teams, spectators and officials, and engage in no form of verbal, physical or sexual harassment or abuse.
8. I understand that I may be required to participate in competition drug testing. By executing this form I agree to abide by and/or participate in such programs. I understand that failure to participate in competition drug testing upon request will result in a sanction.
9. I agree that the dedication, training, physical conditioning, and emotional stability required to compete in ski racing is not compatible with the effects caused by the use of illegal drugs or alcohol, and that I am banned from alcohol and illegal drug use.

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Form E

The goal of Alyeska Ski Club (ASC), and the Glacier Valley Ski Education Foundation (GVSEF) is to make ski-racing fun for athletes of all ages. Therefore, it is imperative that athletes, coaches, parents, families, spectators and race officials conduct themselves with the highest degree of sportsmanship. To facilitate this objective, both the USSA and ASC/GVSEF have a Code of Conduct for the athletes, and the GVSEF has also implemented a Parent's Code of Conduct.

Specifically, everyone associated with the ASC ski-racing program will be expected to promote a constructive and positive atmosphere both on and off the hill. While it is understandable that training and competition can and will breed excitement and high emotion, the ASC and GVSEF Boards believes that spirited training and competition can be experienced without a "win at all cost" mentality.

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in ski racing with the ASC/GVSEF by following this Parents' Code of Conduct.

- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or others.
- I will learn the rules of ski racing and the policies of ASC and GVSEF.
- My guests and I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all athletes, coaches, officials and spectators at any and all races, training and ASC/GVSEF events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health or well being of the athletes.
- I will teach my child to race and train by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will demand that my child treat other racers, coaches, officials and spectators with respect, regardless of race, color, creed, sex or ability.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or another participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I will do my very best to make ski racing fun for my child.
- I will help my child enjoy the ski racing experience by doing whatever I can, such as providing transportation, being a respectful fan or assisting with club duties.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during races and support coaches working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all race events.
- I recognize that the relationship between an athlete and a coach can be altered dramatically by the presence of a parent. Therefore, during training I will do my best to "observe from afar".
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other racers during training and races, unless I am asked to assist by a coach.

As a traveling athlete representing ASSC, Alaska Division Alpine Ski Team or the State of Alaska, I agree to the following terms and conditions:

The use of alcohol, tobacco, or any narcotics is unacceptable and reason for immediate dismissal from the event and further sanctions as necessary.

Athletes are to only travel with the team in team vehicles with a coach. Leaving the team on a personal excursion is not permitted unless a coach deems it necessary and is notified prior to departure. Seatbelts are to be worn at all times when traveling in team vehicles.

Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. While traveling for competition, athletes will display dignity and sportsmanship both on and off the race venue.

Athletes will follow and not question the instructions given to them by their coaches.

Athletes will display self-control, responsible behavior, and consideration for other's well being, courtesy and good manners in public places. Under all conditions: absolutely no abusive, profane or foul language.

Athletes will respect all race officials, ski area employees, lift facilities, ski area boundaries, FIS, USSA, and Alaska Division ski racing rules and regulations.

Rowdy activity and behavior not becoming of an athlete is unacceptable. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate dismissal. Warnings may not be given. The offense will result in a permanent expulsion from your event and an immediate trip home at your expense. Inappropriate behavior consists of but is not limited to: swearing, rough-housing, yelling, interfering with a driver, parent, or coach, taunting or teasing other athletes, damaging in any way the interior or exterior of the van or any property, refusing to wear your seatbelt, or refusing the instructions of the driver or coach.

I understand that by breaking any of the above agreements I will be sent home at the earliest convenience at my own expense.

Alpine Competition "Ski Up" Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnity Agreement

THIS ALPINE COMPETITION "SKI UP" ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is provided by the ATHLETE/COMPETITOR signing the Agreement (the "Athlete") and his/her parent(s) and legal guardian(s) (the "Parent(s)") to UNITED STATES SKI AND SNOWBOARD ASSOCIATION; the DIVISIONS of the UNITED STATES SKI AND SNOWBOARD ASSOCIATION; and the ORGANIZERS AND OFFICIALS of alpine ski racing competitions entered by the Competitor (sometimes hereinafter referred to collectively as the "USSA").

"Ski Up" Definition: On October 30, 1998, the USSA Alpine Sport Executive Committee stated that circumstances may exist for certain athletes in alpine ski competition to be authorized to compete in an age group competition with a class of competitors which are older than the age group designated by USSA. *This release authorizes the athlete to compete in the next older age group, but only in the disciplines in which they are normally eligible and only in the specific competitions authorized by the Program Director.* A competitor who advances to an age category with older competitors will be referred to in this Agreement as "Skiing Up." The opportunity to Ski Up is not automatic, however, and competitors may do so only after they have received authorization through the procedure set forth below and have met additional local requirements that may be discipline specific.

Ski Up Procedure:

1. The procedure for Skiing Up is a request made by a competitor, his/her parents and the competitor's coach to the Regional, Divisional or State Alpine Committee where the competitor resides and the USSA Competition Staff person responsible for the respective State or Division.
2. Authorization to Ski Up is granted and only valid for, the Region, Division or State from which the authorization is provided, based upon a determination by USSA Competition Staff and the applicable Regional, Divisional or State Alpine Committee that the competitor has demonstrated the technical athletic ability to train and compete with an older age category.
3. The parents and competitor acknowledge the additional risks and dangers associated with Skiing Up by signing this Agreement.

General Assumption of Risk – Skiing Has Risks and Dangers: The Competitor and his/her Parents acknowledge that participation in alpine ski competition and training in connection with such ski competitions is hazardous and involves great risk of physical injury or death. The Competitor and his/her Parents expressly assume any and all risk associated with competing or training for or otherwise participating in such competitions, including without limitation, the risks and inherent dangers of ski racing course conditions and those associated with skiing and riding the lifts generally. This assumption of risk also includes changing weather conditions; existing and changing snow conditions; bare spots; rocks; stumps; trees, collisions with natural objects, man-made objects, or other skiers; variations in terrain; and the failure of skiers to ski within their own abilities.

Specific Assumption of Risk – Skiing Up Involves Greater Risks and Dangers: The Competitor and his/her Parents acknowledge that permission to Ski Up is granted by the USSA and the Regional, Divisional or State Alpine Committees, only at the request and recommendation of the Competitor’s coach and Parents, and the request of the Competitor. The request and recommendation has been made by them to provide the Competitor with enhanced opportunities to compete on alpine training and competition courses that will be of greater vertical drop on more challenging terrain in a more intense competitive environment than provided for in USSA rules developed for the standard assigned USSA age class.

By signing this Agreement, the Competitor and his/her parents fully accept the more hazardous, demanding and difficult competition and training situations, and that Skiing Up involves greater risk of physical injury or death with the greater vertical drop on more challenging terrain in a more intense competitive environment.

Release of Claims: In exchange for receiving permission for the Competitor to Ski Up, the Competitor and his/her Parents release and forever discharge the USSA and its trustees, directors, officers, employees, contractors, volunteers, insurers, and all other persons from any and all claims which might arise from accidents, injuries or fatalities that may occur as a result of Skiing Up. This release of claims includes, but is not limited to, those based on negligence, contract and/or breach of warranty.

Covenant Not To Sue: The Competitor and his/her Parents agree not to sue or file any lawsuit, action, arbitration or claim against the USSA if the Competitor or any third-party is physically injured or property is damaged as the result of or connection with the Competitor Skiing Up.

Defense and Indemnity: The Parents of the Competitor agree to defend, indemnify, and hold the USSA harmless from any and all claims or lawsuits brought against the USSA arising out of or in connection with the Competitor Skiing Up.
